




## **BCPS Approval**

After approval via email, volunteers may visit the volunteer portal to input volunteer hours.



- Ask about Meet The Masters communication.




## **HRP Duties**

### **Communication Liaison First**

- Be aware of school events & activities
- Read & Share: Class Dojo, Mrs. W's Callout, HRPs Chat, PTA Updates
- Reposting helps a lot!
- **HRPs Chat:** Post & Re-post (for school-wide consistency )

# **About the Money**






- We encourage electronic collections. Decide the best way to receive payments and inform your class.
- Note your teacher's birthday (Preference Sheet).
- Send out all collection notices in a timely manner.
- Keep receipts and track all moneys received / spent.
- Separate collections, no bundles (preferred).
- About reminders and gentle reminders.

## **Getting Started**

### What next?








From your mobile



- Only go to your designated class when coming on campus – don't walk around to different areas.




## Meet The Masters Chair: Natalia Rodriguez
