
### Q: WHO CAN JOIN THE PTA & WHAT IS THE COST?

Beautification	TBD (Typically October)	Assist with planning & promoting this fun family day of beautifying our school with planting and cleaning up. Help maintain school gardens.
Book Fair	Twice a year	Setup, cashier, family night, etc. Sign up will be for specific days and times.
Budget Committee	As needed	Assist the treasurer in planning the PTA's budget for approval by the executive board.
Communications	Ongoing	Provide information to parents via our website, facebook, and update the pta signs.
Field Day	December	Assist your child's class and/or other grades with this school wide olympic-style event.
Sunshine & Fundraising	Ongoing	Assist in the planning and execution of general fundraising events and spreading "sunshine" across our school.
Holiday Shop	December	Assist students with shopping and gift wrapping.
Hospitality	Ongoing	Assist with planning, setting up, and decorating for various school events.

Italian Night & Silent Auction	Once a year	Assist with our annual dinner, teacher talent show, theme baskets, & auction items.
Meet The Masters	Once a month	Present famous paintings and art in your child's classroom. Training provided. No experience needed. Two volunteers per class preferred (minimum).
Principal Honor Roll	Once every quarter	Coordinate and/or assist with honoring our Straight-A Students with a special treat, medals, and a picture bulletin board.
BUG Awards (Bring Up Grade)	Once every quarter	Coordinate an awards ceremony for our most improved students.
Reflections	Ongoing	Help collect submissions for this national PTA contest with students creating original works in dance choreography, visual arts, music composition, photography, film production, special arts or literature.
